Baptismal Certificates needed:

If your family is new to our Faith Formation Program or you have a child preparing for the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Eucharist or Confirmation, enclose a copy of your child's baptismal certificate with your registration.

If your child was baptized at any of the tri-parish communities of St. Charles, St. Mary's, or St. Michael's, you can simply note which church on your registration making sure to include the exact date.
